

THE COVENANT (EPISODE 21)

Welcome back to Jedi Training. The title of this podcast is The Covenant.

Just about every superhero in scripture had a covenant with the Almighty.

That's a prerequisite in spiritual warfare.

And that means this is going to be one of the most important podcasts in the series.

You're going to have to make a covenant with the Almighty.

Now, what does Jesus tell us?

Jesus tells us that the Lord is one God.

You've got to think about that.

Jesus tells us to worship the Almighty.

The prayer is our Father, not our Jesus.

And so a lot of Christians are confused about that.

And you have a lot of preachers out there that are basically, you know, using a lot of terms to try to, you know, describe the Almighty as something different.

Jesus tells us quite clearly, the Lord is one God.

Jesus teaches us to worship the Almighty.

And therefore, your covenant has to be with the Almighty.

This is very important.

That's the way Moses did it.

That's the way Abraham did it.

That's the way Noah did it.

Now, you might assume that you're already covered by a covenant.

But what's important to realize here, especially in Jedi training, is that our goal is to manifest everything that we can in the Bible in the physical world.

And so if they did it, we do it.

That's basically how it's done.

So we have to enter into a covenant with the Almighty.

Now, your covenant is going to be based on your words and your intent.

And so if your intention is to be, you know, the family guy or the family girl, you know, that's a noble vocation.

There's nothing wrong with that.

But that's a whole different type of covenant.

The kind of covenant that we're searching for is a covenant to fight in this war against evil on behalf of the kingdom of heaven.

Now, this is, you know, this is something else.

And if you put these words together with the intent of fighting evil on behalf of the kingdom of heaven, that's justification.

Now, you have to think about a covenant as like a marriage.

You have to be faithful.

You have to be available.

You have to be dependable.

That means no cheating.

That means no philandering.

Think about how people, you know, treat marriage these days.

You know, they cheat on their spouse.

They get divorced.

They don't take it seriously.

And it's all about faithfulness, being faithful, being committed.

So a covenant is like a marriage.

If you enter into a covenant with the Almighty, you're married.

That's your vocation.

You have to live by those vows.

Now, we can't exactly tell you what to say, but we would appreciate you not using the word Jedi in your vows to the Almighty.

Because we use the term Jedi as a metaphor for fighting the dark side.

Almost like a marketing ploy, really.

But it's accurate to a certain extent.

It's very accurate, especially when you think about the telekinetics and the fighting.

And what we're up against.

It's basically an intergalactic force of evil.

The remnants of previously living civilizations that are coming back to haunt the image bearers of the Almighty.

And that's what we are.

We are created in the image of the Almighty.

And so we are the image bearer of the Almighty.

We are unique in the universe.

And there are many civilizations that have been wiped out, but remain, spiritually, as a disembodied consciousness that is basically haunting and seeking revenge against Earth and humans for various reasons.

This is part of the dynamics of what we're up against.

But we're very special.

And the Almighty loves to empower the meek and the weak.

And so, if you step up to the plate and you ask to be part of this army for the kingdom of heaven, it will be taken seriously.

It's like enlisting.

But without a covenant, it's going to be very difficult for you to move forward with Jedi training.

And so you're going to have to find the time to come up with the right words and to find the right setting where you can commit to the Almighty.

He's always listening.

And He'll take you seriously.

That's all.

Now you have to think about everything that we've discussed all the way up to here.

What you're going to be facing.

All the things that you're going to need.

You're going to need to be somewhat financially independent.

You're going to need to be able to get shielding.

You're going to need to be able to, you know, have the time and the space to dedicate yourself to this fight.

And this isn't a vocation for everyone.

It's very, very difficult.

But if this is the direction that you really want to go, a covenant is a prerequisite.

It's absolutely necessary.

And again, you know, many of you might think you're already covered by a covenant.

That you're already part of a covenant.

But it's important that you say the words.

That you commit.

That you make this agreement.

That you have these vows.

That you've done this for yourself.

Essentially, it's the road to prophecy.

And that, you know, entails a lot.

But you're going to need that gift.

You're going to need that talent to excel in spiritual warfare.

Because you're going to need to see the enemy.

You're going to need to see what's going on beyond your location.

And so entering into a covenant with the Almighty is the first big step in that direction.

And once you do that, then you better start preparing.

Because if you enlist, you're going to war.

It's just a matter of time.

Whether you like it or not.

So, take it seriously.

Another thing that we would like to add to this is that if you have a covenant, then you should have an ark for that covenant.

Now you really might be thinking to yourself, this is something else.

Take it seriously.

What should you have in your ark of the covenant?

Your Bible.

That sums up everything.

That's the word.

That's your justification.

That's your source of wisdom and knowledge.

And, to a certain extent, spiritual power.

What does that mean if you have an ark of a covenant?

That means that you better protect it.

You better treat it with respect.

It can't be like, you know, some other book on the bookshelf.

It has to have its own space.

Of course, you know, you're not going to worship it.

You can't turn it into idolatry.

But, it is special.

That is the word of the Almighty.

And so, you have to treat it with respect.

And, you have to protect it.

And, you have to take it everywhere with you if you travel.

You can't just leave it behind for somebody to desecrate.

It also becomes an artifact that, if captured, will be used by the dark side to a certain extent.

And, so, you've seen the images of the heathen burning Bibles and the like.

That's what they do.

Oh, I've got some interference from the dark side.

We may have to cut this pretty short.

I just love these people when they just show up out of the bushes.

But, essentially, you're going to have to protect your ark of the covenant.

And, it's going to, you know, travel with you.

And, it's going to be with you for the rest of your life.

And, so, all you need is your Bible in a bag, if you will.

And, you know, a nice backpack or something that you can travel and bring with you.

Keep it clean.

Protect it from the heathen.

Protect it from the dark side.

And, keep it with you.

Put it in a high place.

Separate it from all the other books.

And, in fact, this should be the only book that you own.

This is where you should be spending your time.

And, again, you should be listening to the Bible every day.

Because, faith comes from the spoken word.

Faith is an important component to what we do.

But, it's not the only component.

So, you know, we're called to be charitable.

We're called to be virtuous.

We're called to be good people.

Oh, they're leaving.

You know, they come here and they park like, you know, like they want to be part of the studio audience.

I mean, I'm not even going to rant and rage when it comes to these people.

But, they're spooky, man.

They try to interrupt your show.

They do everything they can.

So, San Francisco.

Anyways, I'm not going to let them get the better of me.

I'm not going to lose my cool.

It's what they want.

They want to interrupt.

And, I don't have video.

I can't show you what, you know, just happened here.

But, basically, you know, I'm out here in the remote wilderness.

In the middle of the woods.

And, these people basically just drive up to my location.

Park.

Stop.

And, stare at you.

Try to make you feel, like, uncomfortable.

Right?

I'm not going to digress.

But, eventually, they, you know, they took off.

And, this is not a place where, you know, they had any reason to stop.

I mean, they just basically parked, like, right in front of me.

This is the second time this happened.

I had to restart another podcast.

The other people were even more belligerent.

But, anyways.

Getting back to the discussion.

You know, we're called to manifest everything that we can that's in Scripture.

We're to repeat it.

To live it out.

And, so, everything that's in there, we should be trying to do it.

There's a time and place for everything.

You know, there'll be a time and a place to take out the Jezebel.

There'll be a time and a place to take out New Babylon.

There'll be a time and a place to take out Pharaoh and, you know, the pyramid on the back of the dollar bill and all of that.

But, there's also a time for having a covenant.

And, of course, you know, your covenant is based on the Bible.

So, you know, making some kind of ark.

And, it doesn't have to be like, you know, as extravagant as in the days of Moses.

In fact, we're really not called to make idols and the like.

But, you know, like having cherubim or angels and all of that.

But, it should reflect your covenant.

It should be, you know, ready to go into battle with you.

And, you may have to move around.

So, you know, find, you know, some kind of suitable, you know, containment for the Bible.

The Bible is the basis of your covenant.

And, so, have a symbolic ark of that covenant that protects the Bible, that protects the word of the Almighty.

And, you know, cherish it, protect it.

That's your treasure.

Remember what Jesus told us about the kingdom of heaven.

It's like a treasure.

It's where your heart is.

And, so, you should protect it and not let anyone desecrate it.

And, they will try to desecrate it.

Absolutely.

As soon as you have your back turned, don't trust anybody near it.

Lock that door.

Be the only one that has the key.

But, you know, I wouldn't recommend live, you know, surveillance through the internet, through the beast system.

Don't get that extravagant.

But, you know, make sure that it's safe and secure.

That is a very important symbol of what you're all about.

And, so, if you're the type of Christian that just leaves the Bible on the floor next to the garbage or something.

You know, I don't want to say shame on you, but yeah, shame on you.

Don't put it next to other books.

Don't put it next to the heathen books.

It should have its own space.

It should be, you know.

I don't want to call it a shrine.

But, it should be, you know, important.

So, there you go.

You got your covenant.

You got your Ark of the Covenant.

And, once you have that,

well, you've taken a big step

in the right direction.

Of course, you have to know the Bible by heart.

There's no replacing that.

Everything that I'm going to, you know, talk to you about in the future
is based on Scripture.

And, if your heart isn't there,
then you're going to be, you know, part of the dark side.

But,

the power that we basically
connect to

through Scripture

is beyond anything

the dark side can,

you know,

conjure up,

to say the least.

It's kind of like that saying,

you know,

no amount of darkness

can overcome the light.

And so, I mean,

you can see glitches in the Matrix,

you can see shadows and the like,

but,

you know,

you can be in the darkest room,
and as soon as,
you know,
you,
as soon as you light up a candle or something,
I mean,
it illuminates
that darkness.
It's the natural remedy.
And so,
the power that's going to be,
you know,
coming through you
is enormous.
But you have to remember,
it's not you,
it's what you represent.
It's what you represent.
And so,
you have to take everything super seriously,
like,
you're one of these
characters
in Scripture.
And chances are,
I mean,

you're going to have that spirit
flowing through you.

As Christians,
we all have the spirit of Jesus
flowing through us.

And that's,
you know,
the beginning of the journey.

So,
it kind of starts with baptism,
and then you,
you learn,
and you grow,
and you affirm your faith,
and if you're really paying attention,
you'll dedicate yourself
through a covenant,
and then
you'll engage this enemy.

And of course,

I mean,

it's,
you start on the local level.

You don't start,

you know,
on the intergalactic level.

So to speak.

You start on the local level.

And we'll get into

all of that pretty soon.

So,

your homework right now

is to really know the Bible by heart.

Listen to it

all the time.

You should be making armor.

You should be acquiring

armor,

and,

you know,

shielding materials.

And as you make armor,

you should be listening to scripture.

You should be listening to preachers.

You should be listening to

things that are

related to faith.

And that should be the domain of,

of what you're exposed to.

Anything else is pretty much

of the dark side.

And you should be training yourself,

you know,
physically,
mentally,
spiritually,
for the battles that are coming.

And, you know,
there's a lot to talk about.

There's basically,
you know,
an endless array of subjects
to talk about.

And so,
this is going to get
real interesting.

Real fast.

But we really want to cover
the basics
so that you're prepared
for what's coming.

So,
at this stage,
you've got a lot of homework.

You know,
spend all the time
that you can
listening to the Bible.

Faith comes from the spoken word.

Faith is super important.

You know,

there's a lot of preachers that,

you know,

just focus on faith

and then they make it like

faith versus works.

But,

remember that sin

brings condemnation.

And so,

we're not necessarily

talking about,

you know,

being

legal experts

in a sense,

but we should be.

because,

you know,

violating the law

and the ordinances

basically means that

you're

committing sin

and sin

brings

condemnation.

You know,

endless,

you know,

cities,

towns,

countries,

civilizations

have been wiped out

because of sin.

And so,

if you don't think

that it's important,

you know,

if you don't think

the law is important,

you know,

think again.

So,

that's,

you know,

stuff that we're

going to get into

and talk about

relentlessly

as well as other topics.

But,

we got to,

we got to focus on

faith.

We got to focus on

virtue.

We got to focus on

avoiding sin.

And,

there's no replacing

knowing the Bible

because,

unless you can keep

your nose out of trouble,

then you're really not

going to be able to

get off ground floor.

If you're always just,

you know,

basically in a state

of uncleanness,

then you're not

that much different

than the unclean spirits

that we're trying to find.

So,

you basically have to be

in a state of,

you know,

virtue,

you know,

you have to be a do-gooder,

you know,

from A to Z.

And the,

and the purest definition

of,

you know,

being a do-gooder

is right there

in the Bible.

So,

know Scripture by heart.

Don't just,

you know,

repeat what other people

are saying.

Go straight to the source.

Know it.

And that way,

you can see for yourself
what Jesus is actually
preaching.

You can see for yourself
what the other people
in Scripture experienced
and,

you know,
take it literally.

And we'll get into
all of that
in a future podcast.

So,
your homework,
you know,
armor,
shielding,
knowing the Bible,
preparing yourself,

you know,
financially,
resources,
all of that,
setting up a safe house
and,
you know,

when you're ready,
make your vows,
make a covenant,
renounce evil,
commit yourself
to fighting
for the kingdom of heaven,
for the glory
of the kingdom
against
the kingdom of darkness.
and,
you know,
commit yourself
to the spiritual war
and you'll be on your way
to being a
quote-unquote Jedi,
if you will.
Really a,
you know,
priestly warrior class.
And so,
that's what it's going to take
for you to make a difference.
And,

you know,
not all of you are going to be able to,
you know,
succeed,
succeed,
but for those that do,
you're going to have a tremendous impact
on this war.

Again,
we're,
you know,
we're kind of exclusive
in the sense that
we're the image bearers
of the Almighty
and so,
we're capable of doing a lot more
than just,
you know,
driving a car
and talking on the phone.
And you'll see that for yourself,
but I mean,
you know,
the road to get there
is faith.

And,

you know,

the rest will come naturally.

We'll leave it there for this podcast.
