

PREACHING THE GOSPELS (EPISODE 32)

Welcome back to Jedi Training. The title of this podcast is Preparing for Evangelism.

Evangelism is a key part of spiritual warfare.

This war against evil happens on all fronts, and really there's nothing more powerful than the original works of evangelism.

It takes a lot of courage to evangelize to strangers and to the Christian community.

And it means that you have to know scripture by heart, and this is at the core of spiritual warfare.

If you don't know scripture better than the scribes, then you really can't be part of this army.

And so, essentially, being an evangelist is a requirement, a prerequisite for spiritual warfare.

And, you know, you can try it on the street corner.

That's, you know, where it gets real tough.

Or you can do it online.

But you basically need to put it together.

And be a disciple of Jesus.

And take it seriously.

And reach out to people.

And reach out to people in the right way, with the right message.

You know, a lot of people out there are repeating the mainstream narratives, if you will, from the churches.

People just want to fit in, and they just repeat what other people are saying.

But, essentially, what we need to do as spiritual warriors is harmonize with the truth.

And to really focus on what Jesus was saying during his ministry versus what other people were saying after his ministry.

And that may and does include the apostles that all ran away on that fateful day.

But, listen to what Jesus is saying.

In Matthew 7, verse 21.

Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven.

But he that doeth the will of my Father, which is in heaven.

Think about what that means there.

Profoundly. Unpack it. Focus on every word.

Jesus was preaching in the synagogues.

Jesus was observing the Passover and the Sabbath.

And he's telling people to do the will of the Almighty.

Like it's written in Scripture.

When you go to church today, what are you seeing?

You're seeing people just basically worship statues of Jesus and Mary.

And that's become their religion.

But that's not what Jesus was saying.

Another example.

Powerful example from Scripture.

But to sit on my right hand and on my left hand is not mine to give.

But it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared by my Father.

And that, again, tells us that there's definitely a distinction.

Many Christians today are worshiping Jesus when they should be worshiping the Almighty.

That was the message.

And, of course, modern churches have found a way to pervert that message in a way that seems acceptable.

But essentially, everyone, just about everyone out there in Christian churches are practicing spiritual adultery.

And that, of course, is a very offensive remark for anyone with half a brain.

But this is the message that needs to be put out there.

This is the message that needs to be harmonized.

And it also needs to focus on what's important, which is the law.

And why is it important?

It's because the Almighty asked us to observe it.

And so, you know, people are out there thinking that they're saved, living like devils.

And it's just the wrong message that's being put out there.

Everybody thinks they're saved.

And in reality, it's back to Matthew 7, verse 21.

And it goes on in verse 22.

Many will say to me on that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name,
and in thy name have cast out devils, and in thy name done many wonderful works?

And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you.

Now, depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

So, people don't realize just how far off message they really are
until you hit them with it over and over again.

And I know that this is at the core of the mass deception.

People are worshiping Jesus, thinking they're doing the right thing.

Everybody loves Jesus.

Obviously, Jesus is our hero.

Jesus saves.

Jesus is the way.

But Jesus tells us that the destination is the Almighty.

And nothing in Scripture is going to change.

He didn't come to rewrite Scripture or destroy Scripture.

He came to fulfill Scripture.

And that really needs to be at the core of your evangelism.

But again, if you're going to be a serious contender on the battlefield,

then you need to be an evangelist.

And so, you've got to put some work in.

You've got to put some time in.

This isn't about me or you or STF.

This is about the glory of the kingdom.

But we know that this is the way.

And it works.

Just like we know STF works.

We've reached over a billion people over the last 10 years

who have had a huge impact on society, believe it or not.

And it's basically been a one-man show on an entry-level laptop.

We didn't spend the millions of dollars like a lot of these studios spend to put out their propaganda.

We just kept it simple and stuck with the truth.

And the truth has set some of us free.

So, I'm not in the wasting your time business.

And that's why we're focusing on telekinetics.

I know it works.

But to get there, you have to be an evangelist.

That's basically the first calling, is to evangelize,

to preach the gospels, to heal the sick, to cleanse the lepers,

to raise the dead, and to cast out devils, to hunt them down.

And basically, to hunt them down, you're using supernatural powers.

You're not using, for the most part,

like a legal notice.

Please vacate the premises, etc., etc.

But...

You know, it can be simple, as simple as...

Speaking to the unclean spirits to leave.

But, you know, like we've said, they come back.

Most people are like a city without walls.

It doesn't resolve the issue.

We basically have to hunt them down

and disrupt their operations on their home territory,

which is essentially...

deep into outer space.

I know how that sounds, especially from...

the perspective of the flat earth community.

But...

it's our impression that...

the universe is basically as infinite...

looking up as it is looking in a microscope.

You know, try counting all the bacteria that you find

in one milliliter of tap water,

or pond water, or something.

There's a whole universe in a microscope.

And there's a whole universe in a telescope.

And our perspective is that...

it's basically infinite both ways.

You know, from the microbe, to the DNA,

to the atoms, to the quarks.

I mean, you just...

it's just one universe after another.

It just doesn't end.

And so...

basically...

you know, we're hunting ghosts in outer space

through...

advanced telepathy.

Sounds, you know...

sounds like a long shot, but...

of all the things that I've...

tried thus far,

it seems to be by far the most effective.

And...

it's what the dark side fears the most.

So these are spiritual entities

that have to be dealt with

with spiritual weapons.

But to develop your spiritual weapons,

you have to develop your spiritual life.

And to do that, it really begins with...

evangelism.

I think a lot of people these days

are kind of shy and...

you know, they just want to stay to themselves,

but...

you have to work on that courage factor.

And once you evangelize,
once you...
start putting content out there
and start saving people,
that's...
going to be credit...
on your spiritual...
credit score.

And so you want to get as many points as you can
and save as many people as you can.
And you're probably not going to be able to save
many of the heathen, but...
saving Christians from themselves,
from the mainstream churches,
is an easy way to earn a lot of points.

And so...
you know, during the earthly ministry of Jesus,
he focused on people of faith,
saving them from themselves,
from the doctrines of the Pharisees
and the Sadducees and the like.

And so...
that's basically our role as beginners
in spiritual warfare.
That's one way to fight...
on the battlefield.

And it's a very effective way.

And it makes a huge difference.

And the more people that we have
harmonized with...

the real message of Jesus

versus the message of the mainstream...

churches out there, the better.

And so I know this probably doesn't sound
like the most...

you know, interesting podcast,
but it really is.

To be a preacher means that
you have to know Scripture.

And knowing Scripture means that...

you're prepared to get on the battlefield.

When you're confronted with something,
Scripture will come into your mind
and address that concern,
address that issue.

It tells you everything you need to know,
everything that's coming your way.

It's basically your handbook on life.

And not knowing it by heart
is basically a crime.

And not trying to...

live it out

is a crime as well.

And so we're called to...

know the law

and the ordinances.

And Jesus tells us that

He didn't come to change the law,

but to fulfill Scripture.

I think that's a real important thing

to understand because, again,

a lot of people are out there

living like devils,

thinking that they're saved,

but they really need to save

themselves from themselves.

You know,

loving Jesus

and accepting Jesus

as your Savior

is a first step

in the right direction.

But it's just the first step.

And the longer you're on this

straight and narrow path,

the better.

And the longer you're on it,

you know,

the more you're going to see
and the more you're going to do.
But if you're only there
like part-time
or not even at all,
you take a step
and then you do the hokey-pokey
and turn yourself around,
then, you know,
you're back on Broadway.
On that Broadway
that leads to destruction.
So, you know,
being a Christian
is a vocation
all to itself.
It's a lifestyle choice.
Nobody can force you
to want to be this way.
But listening to
Scripture every day
makes a huge difference.
When you hear, you know,
Jesus talk
and you're thinking to yourself,
there's my hero,

you're on the right path.

But if you're always

tuned in to something else,

then

you're on the wrong path.

And obviously,

it requires a lot of time

to

really advance

as a Christian.

It takes a lot of dedication.

and it takes, you know,

a whole lot of heart

and courage

and

endurance

and patience,

especially these days.

It's tough.

But it's meant to be tough.

And

the tougher it gets,

the

stronger you're going to get.

And, you know,

we've been trying to prepare people

in a way
and it's probably a little
counterproductive.

You know,
when Scripture says,
you know,
carry your cross
and come after me.

I mean,
you know,
a lot of people
don't realize
what that really means.

And
you know,
if there was a shop
in town,
you know,
selling that to you,
where people are like,
you know,
forced to carry a cross
and get,
you know,
scourged
and humiliated

and

persecuted

and all that,

I doubt anybody

would sign up.

I doubt anybody

would buy

for the most part.

and so

we try not to talk

about it,

but it's tough.

But there's nothing

like

being on that path

to make you

spiritually mature.

You know,

life comes and goes.

We're here like a vapor,

as it says.

just a moment

in time.

But,

you know,

this is an opportunity

for us to
do something
worthwhile.

And
once you start
seeing action,
I mean,
it's,
there's no going
back,
really.

There's no going
back to normal.

You know,
if somebody were
to take it away
from you,
you'd be like,
I don't know.

Can't imagine
being a normie,
even though that's
all you beg for
as you're carrying
your cross.

But,

there's nothing
quite like
seeing what's
out there.

So,
you know,
most of you,
most people,
including myself,
just,
you know,
will never be
prepared for
what's out there.

But,
the best place
to start,
by far,
is
being an evangelist.

Even if you don't
go any further
than that.

I mean,
that's,
you know,

a vocation
all to itself.
There's nothing
more fulfilling,
spiritually,
than
knowing
scripture
and
getting people
on the right
track.
Not just
getting people
quote unquote
saved,
but making
sure that they
stay on that
path and
mature,
spiritually,
to be a light
in their
community.
That's,

you know,
that's how this
is supposed to
work.

Paying it
forward,
training people
in,
sending them
out there,
so that they
can do
the original
works.

So that's
what we
need to do.

There's no
improving on
that.

And there's
no
ignoring it
or
not doing
it.

So we're
going to do
a ministry
here pretty
soon,
really thinking
about,
you know,
all the little
things,
but everybody
should be doing
that as well.

You know,
what are you
going to
call it?

You know,
how are you
going to
present
scripture?

What are you
going to
talk about?

And,

you know,
where are you
going to
post it?

All of that
stuff.

How are you
going to
fit it in
your schedule?

And,
you know,
some people
may want to
do it in a
physical way.

Maybe there's,
you know,
a small church
in your community
that's waiting
to be
resurrected,
if you will.

So,
we all have

different talents,
but there
should be
something that's
on everybody's
mind anyways.

But there is
no becoming,
you know,
a spiritual
warrior,
a priestly
warrior,
a Jedi,
without being
a priest,
really,
to people in
your community.

or,
you know,
in some
community
out there
on the
internet.

So,
you may not
like the
people where
you're at,
but you
definitely need
to reach out
to Christians
out there
and,
you know,
focus on
all of
these passages
and Matthew,
Mark,
and Luke,
and John
that makes
the distinction
between,
you know,
Jesus and
the Father.
And,

you know,
Jesus never
taught people
to worship
Jesus.

I mean,
people worship
Jesus,

but,
you know,
he was
basically telling
people,
the kingdom
of heaven
has come.

So,
that's the
message.
challenge.

And so,
prepare to
evangelize out
there.

That's the
big challenge

that faces

everyone.

As soon as

you can

get enough

courage to

evangelize

to our

peers out

there,

you know,

the more

courage you're

going to have

for the

battlefield.

And you

need courage.

You need to

be able to

face your

fears,

all of

them.

we're not

taught to

fear the
secular world
or the
dark side.
So,
that doesn't
mean that
we're supposed
to do stupid
things,
but,
look,
we're supposed
to overcome
our fears
and have
courage
and
do what
it takes.
So,
this is an
excellent place
to start,
excellent
project,

and obviously
all of this
is going to
take time,
but we want
to put all
of this out
there for
people to
pick up on,
because it
is a war,
and there's
no guarantees
in war.

We've had
quite a few
close calls,
and,
you know,
it's not
over yet.
so,
we hope
that eventually
we get

enough people
on the
battlefield
that it's
just going
to become
normal for
Christians again
to fight
like this.
evangelism is
key,
so,
focus on
that,
know the
scripture
better than
the scribes,
live it out
better than
the Pharisees
or the
Sadducees,
things.
And,

things will
come naturally.

Again,
everything that
we're talking
about,
that we have
talked about,
that we will
talk about,
it all comes
naturally.

It's all
instinctual.

Just follow
your instincts,
just do what
comes natural,
focus on
taking out
the dark
side,
and it
just
flows like
a river.

Leave it
there for
this podcast.
