You know, you're looking around.

In scripture, they talk about casting you out.
Into the darkness or into the outer darkness.
Back in the day with no electricity, no street lights.
Going up and down the Roman highways.
Or, something even older than that.
I mean, that would just be the worst.
Having to spend the night in the pitch black.
Would be the worst.
Be torture.
And, we're confronted with this darkness.
Every day.
And, sometimes.
Like in the winter.
It's nearly total darkness.
And, practically living in darkness.
And, so the darkness.
Obviously is a bad thing.
Now, as Jedi.
We are.
Going after metaphysical evil.
And, metaphysical evil resides near.
The darkness.
Like flies on.
You know what.
You know how flies come into the world.
Right?

They're totally black.

Total darkness.

Usually black things in nature.

Darkness in nature.

In creation.

Is a bad thing.

Black mold.

You know.

For the most part.

So.

It's pretty much.

But there can be.

Exceptions.

In certain places.

So.

Maybe at a church.

Maybe.

It's would.

It's a great argument.

But.

It's a great■ng sieht.

It's probably.

There can be.

Is a big structure.

It's de Traditionalism.

It's real.

in all of these ideas, but pretty much most of the time.

So the darkness is the vector that not only brings us into the spiritual world,

but also brings the spiritual world to us, and most of it is pretty much evil.

So this is something to talk about, because what you'll see in the darkness is not only spooky, but it's the evil that we're after, and it's the evil that's after you.

So we're not only hunters, but we're the hunted. We're mostly the hunted.

But Christians have been persecuted and tortured for thousands of years, if not longer.

People of faith have always been a target way back to Adam and Eve.

And so, you know, it's mostly being hunted, but you try to hunt the evil.

I mean, that's just the only thing that I can come up with.

It seems to work, and it seems to really piss them off, and so I think I'm on to something.

But it's like a suicide mission, and you really have to believe.

And yet, you know, is this the right way to go about it?

I don't have time for that debate once again.

I could give you the quick of the long of it, but I know that there are wars in Scripture, that fighting against evil is something that we're called to do.

And, you know, in a 1950s scenario, where everybody's going to church,

I think you can be a little more, you know, tolerant.

Like the way it is in the Gospels.

But today, in the middle of a genocide, in a killing field,

where people are being killed massively,
and Christians are, you know, under threat of extinction,
I think that sometimes you've just got to do things that you just wouldn't otherwise do.
But usually when you justify things that way, it's a bad decision.
I have to be honest with you.
There's only one right way of doing things.
And everything else is bad news.
And so, there's reasons to think that this is the right thing to do,
and there's reasons to think that this is not the right thing to do.
I mean, who goes out there fighting demons and the like?
Well, Jesus did that, but...
You know, this is taking it to a whole new level, really.
And yet, this can't be our religion.
This is not our religion.
This is extracurricular activity.
And so, as Christians, we should always be listening to Scripture
and thinking about what's there.
And just trying to stay out of trouble.
But, given that it looks like a full-blown alien invasion
and that I really don't have much choice,
and given I feel like I've discovered something here,
I want to share it with those that can understand.
Not everybody's going to understand what I'm talking about,
for the most part.
But, some people will understand.
And for some people, this will connect some dots.

And some people will have to try harder, and, you know,
they'll get there.

It usually takes about 10,000 hours
to get good at something.

So, if you want to be a good Christian,
then you basically want to be spending 10,000 hours
doing Christian-like stuff,
like listening to the Gospels and the like.

Because everything else, I mean,
should go rather quickly.

Being charitable, courteous.

Are you going to count the seconds that you're nice to somebody?

But,

in any case,

when it comes to telekinetics

and all of that,

and thinking about,

you know,

what happened to the fig tree,

you know,

it takes a while.

And it takes a lot of confidence,

and it takes,

you know,

further understanding.

We can only really just kind of like,

give you a road map.

But,

taking the time to think about it

as something else,

and then actually having the dedication

is another thing.

Because,

it's a lot of work.

Being a Christian and being a Jedi,

to say the least,

it's all you do.

You're just out there like a wrecking ball,

trying to do as much damage as you can.

Really.

In a good way.

So,

we're out there hunting the evil

and the darkness,

and as you practice more,

you're going to see more.

And,

you're going to see that

in the darkness,

it's definitely more spooky

with your augmented vision.

and so,

again,
you have to think about
going to the twilight zone
as learning how to turn on
your augmented reality hardware,
your lucid dreaming hardware,
to see places,
and to project into those locations,
like a ninja,
like an invisible ninja.

I guess,
in theory,
on the other side,
you must either not look like
anything,
or if you do,
perhaps you look like
some of the enigmas
that you will encounter
in spiritual warfare.

So,
in summary,
spiritual warfare is really just
putting it all together.
Doing everything you can
that's positive,

and that makes a difference
and that basically
sweeps some of the dirt
out of the way.

Everything that you do
should be basically,
like,
have a general theme to it,
like,
doing the right thing,
going in the right direction,
going up,
not down,
saying hi,
not hello,
like hell is low.

Let's see.

So,
there's a,
there's a circular logic
to,
you know,
the right way
going up,
or
the wrong way

and going down.

And,

it's expressed

all throughout

creation,

and in language,

and in

ideology.

But,

essentially,

you're always trying to do

the right thing,

the positive thing,

the thing that,

you know,

brings people

together

going in the right direction.

So,

and,

you know,

more advanced techniques

of that

are the spiritual warfare

aspects of

what we've been talking about,

and
basically,
you're taking out the trash
every which way you can,
at every opportunity
that you can,
to hold the lines
and to
basically purify
an area,
spiritually speaking.
At least you try.
And,
you know,
scripture tells us that
the hosts of heaven
are
very numerous
in nature.
And so,
there's a lot of action
out there.
And,
hopefully,
this action
is beneficial

to our cause,
like
going on the battlefield
and
overcoming
the Philistines
or
something like that.
so there are many
war stories
in scripture
and,
you know,
we just hope that
this is
something that
will make a
broader impact
on what's going on.
Understanding that
what we see here
in this world
is a
reflection,
side effect,
or symptom

of what's happening
in the spiritual world
at a certain level.

And so,
for the most part,
the good guys
are just,
you know,
fighting it out
in a real local
kind of way
while there's this
huge demonic
alien invasion
going on.

And so,
you know,
we're kind of
treating this as
a demonic
alien invasion
enhanced with,
you know,
cyborg technology
and we're,
you know,

trying to
fight the problem
based on the
cause
versus
the symptom.

So,
we're almost like
an antibiotic
for this
demonic disease
that's spreading.

but treating
the problem
basically
is a proven
solution.

That's what
Jesus did.

He cast out
demons and then
people were healed.

You have to
address
the problem
and

based on
what I've seen,
you know,
this problem
is coming from
somewhere and we
can hit this
enemy
in more ways
than just
exercising people
in broad daylight
which only works
as long as the
people,
you know,
stay on the
right track.
fine.

Demonic
possession
tends to be
a symptom
of
poor decision
making,

really.

And people
become like a
city without
walls and
there's an
infestation
of demons.

But these
things are
coming from
somewhere and
they're part of
a bigger picture
which is kind
of like a
hydra,
a thing with
like a body
with many
heads.

And so
all of these
demons that we
encounter on
the planet,

from my
perspective,
are kind of
like satellites
of a bigger
thing,
moons of a
bigger thing,
unit.

And so
they're coming
from somewhere
and they
depend on
something else
for direction,
inspiration,
coordination,
logistics.

That's the way
I'm kind of
looking at it.

So
we've been
hunting for
nearly two

years now

and

I'm hoping

that

we'll get

through all

of these

enemies,

but

it seems

like every

day you

see a new

face.

So

I've seen

a lot of

demonic alien

faces from

other worlds.

and for

some reason

they all

have an

interest on

what's going

on in
this planet.
What we're
up against
truly is
a zoo
of
rabid,
demonic,
alien
civilizations.
aliens.
Kind of
like the
movie
aliens,
but in
ghost form.
Some of
them.
And so
we'll get
into more
of that,
but
the action

is happening

in the

darkness.

darkness.

Once you

get your

skills

set up,

then

start

probing

the

darkness.

Dark

rooms,

turn off

the lights

before you

go to

sleep,

turn

everything

off,

pay

attention

to the

corners

of the

room.

it's

not just

your eyes

playing

tricks

on you.

You're

not the

only one

seeing

these

things.

So it's

real bad.

It's like

Stranger

Things in

a way,

and I

kind of

feel like

they set

up shop

after we
did,
based on
what we
were talking
about at
the time,
but that's
another story.

you see a
lot of
interesting
things there
that,
generally
speaking,
you kind
of see
in the
valleys of
the shadows
of death.

That's
another thing
you'll see
at night

out in
the country,
like,
shadow
vapors
racing
across the
sky.

Trying
to hit
those
things is
there's
some
action
there,
too.

But you've
got to be
careful when
you're just,
you know,
pointing your
sword of the
spirit
around.

Right now,
you know,
some stars
seem like
they're okay,
and other
stars seem
like they're
a little
demonic,
so you
want to
be careful.
people.
But there's
a lot of
darkness
out there
to probe,
and
that's
when you
start
saying to
yourself,
what's

going on?

And by

then,

it's really

too late,

and the

pressure,

you know,

just kind

of builds,

but hopefully,

you know,

you've been

preparing

for this.

I know

some of you

have been,

you know,

following this

series rather

closely,

and some

people are

catching up

to it

as time
goes by,
but,
you know,
once you
encounter
what's out
there,
some of
what's out
there,
and you
feel the
pressure
to survive,
you know,
kick in,
that's when
the learning
curve
accelerates.

You start
believing more,
you start
spending more
time there,

you start
practicing
more,
you start
seeing,
you know,
seeing the
feedback for
yourself,
and you're
saying to
yourself,
man,
you know,
this is
kind of
trippy.

Can this
be really
happening?

You know,
so it's
quite the
adventure,
and I
hope to,

you know,
help in
some ways,
that way,
you'll have
a better
chance of
surviving,
and the
more of
us that
are out
there
gunning
for these
things,
the better
it's going
to be,
and so
the more
people that
we get,
you know,
on the
battlefield,

the better,
and of
course,
my,
you know,
my
descriptions
of what's
going on
will become
better as
time goes
on,
hopefully.
It's been
real difficult
lately.
Bon.
Eventually,
you know,
with any
luck,
we'll get
a couple
hundred people
on the

battlefield,
and I hope
that's going
to be a lot
better than
just,
you know,
me and a
few others,
you know,
gunning for
whatever's
out there.
But it
really takes
a special
character to
enter this
battlefield.
If you're
just kind
of like a
rookie
Christian,
recent
convert,

you know,
then it's
going to be
more difficult,
to say the
least.

And many
lifelong
Christians are
in a totally
different vocation,
which is
understandable.

But as
time goes on,
more people
are going to
want to
fight.

You will
eat bugs,
you will
own nothing.

So,
as time goes on,
there will be

more pressure

to survive,

and some

people will,

you know,

jive with

Christian

telekinetics.

Maybe that's

the way I

should call it

from now on,

you know,

the Christian

telekinetic

academy.

I'm sure

that's going

to fly well.

But,

I don't

know.

But as

more and

more Christians

get into

the idea
of the fig
tree,
I think
the better
off will be,
but again,
it's a double-edged
sword.

I can't
say that I
feel real
Christian
running around,
you know,
doing what
I do.

But I'm
not,
you know,
in Kansas
anymore,
either.

I'm,
like,
way deep

behind enemy

lines.

Like,

I've been

dropped in

Vietnam,

like,

Rambo,

and I'm

the only

dude out

here,

you know,

that gives

a you-know-what

about the

world that we

grew up in,

I'm basically

in zombie

cult land,

you know,

a haunted

zombie cult

land,

where everybody's

super witchy,
and everything
is just
super messed
up.

And so,
for me,
it's just
like,
you know,
back home
is a distant
memory,
unfortunately.

I've been
in exile for
so long
that
it's like
a distant
memory,
you know.

And I've
been,
you know,
in the

trenches
for so long
that
it's like
now the
majority of
my life.

I've been
at war
like the
majority of
my life
now,
pretty much.

But,
this war
has been
going on
for thousands
of years.

So,
I don't
know what
the chances
are of us
winning it

in our
lifetime,
but we're
going to
have to
give it a
try.

We're never
going to
change
anything if
we allow
history to
repeat itself.

So,
let's be
unpredictable
out there,
and that
truly is
key,
being
unpredictable.
because this
enemy knows
what you're

thinking,
and to a
certain extent
it knows
the future,
and,
you know,
its demons
are pretty
much always
watching you.
So,
you have a
real privacy
disadvantage.
So,
try to
randomize,
you know,
what you're
into,
where you go,
if you can.
It's not
always easy.
We're creatures

of habit,
but,
you know,
feel free to
do

random
things.

Walking in
a straight
line can
be a real
good thing,
but not
so hot on
the battlefield.

And when
you start
seeing,
you know,
the fiery
darts of
the enemy,
and you
will see
them,
quite literally,

Ephesians

chapter 6.

Once you
start seeing
the fiery
darts of
the enemy
reign in
or start
shooting in,
then you
know you're
on the
battlefield.

Armor up.

Leave it
there for
this one.
